

Chris has returned to the RSGB Bristol group after an interval of 32 years: welcome back!

Chris has always been an admirer of Marconi. While everyone has heard of John Logie Baird and his TV experiments (whose system never really worked), few have heard of Marconi's (whose did!) or realise that wireless telegraphy and telephony were uniquely British developments in which Marconi played the key role. (Perhaps this is not surprising when members might recall that a few years ago the great British public voted the bicycle the world's greatest invention.)

In 1999, by chance, Chris met Gordon Bussey who was the Marconi / GEC Archivist as well as a Trustee of the Wireless Preservation Society; they became good friends. The latter single handedly prevented the Marconi collection from being dispersed, when in 2001, Marconi plc was going bust. Due to his work, this astonishing archive, all 7 lorry loads, is now safe for the nation in the Museum of the History of Science and the Bodleian Library in Oxford. Gordon Bussey has given Chris a remarkable video on Marconi, one of only two copies in this country. We will see it tonight! Not to be missed ...
