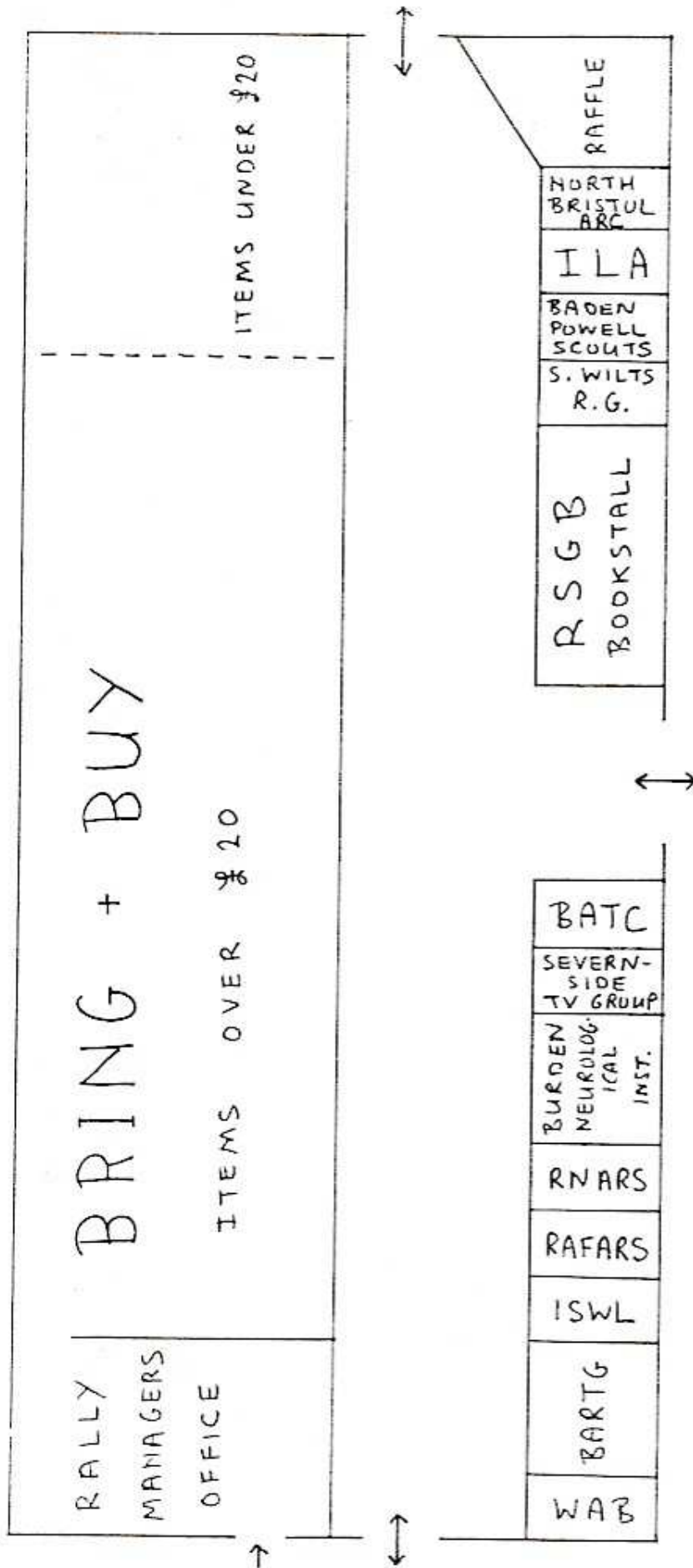

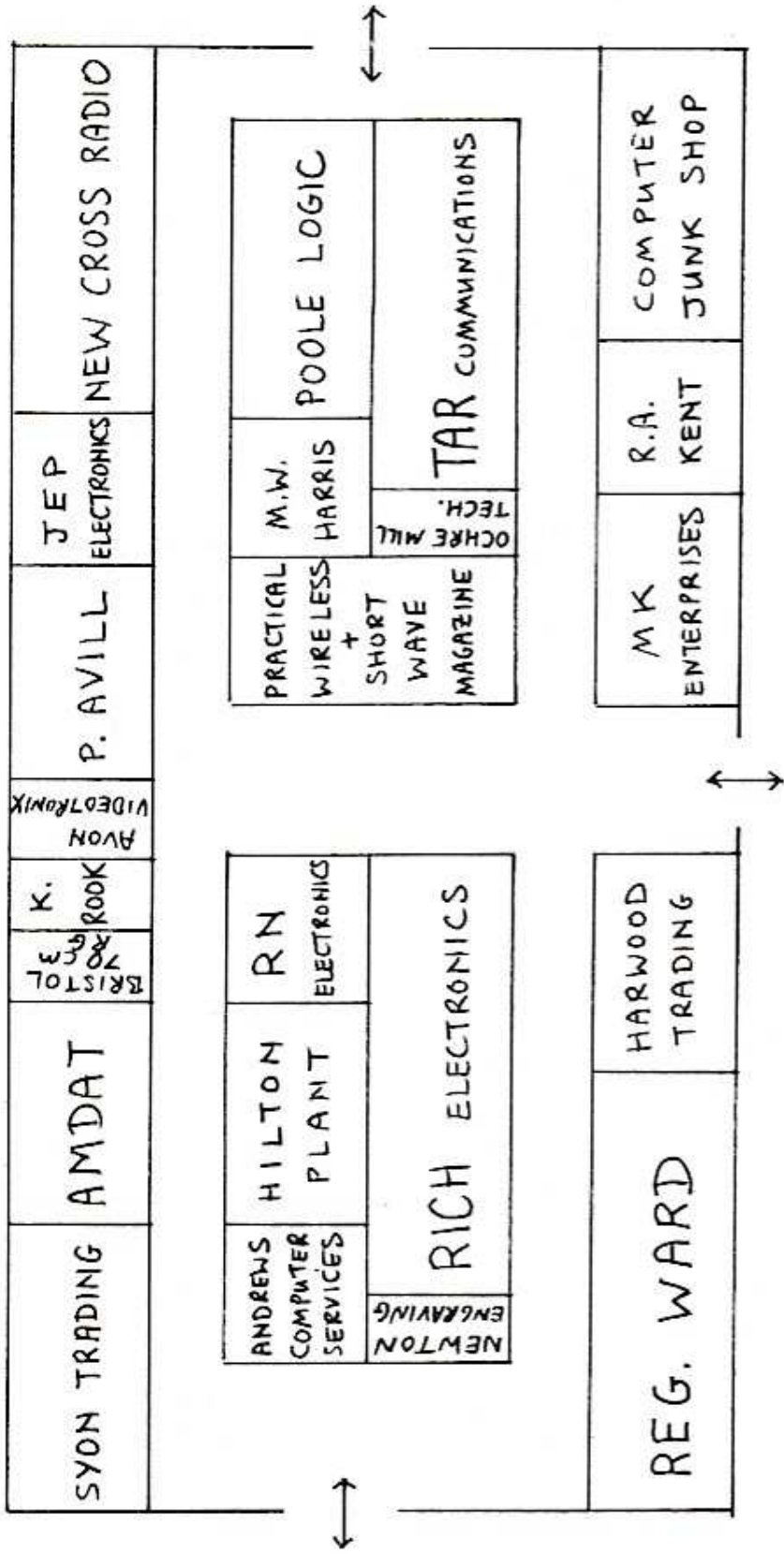
VISITORS PARKING

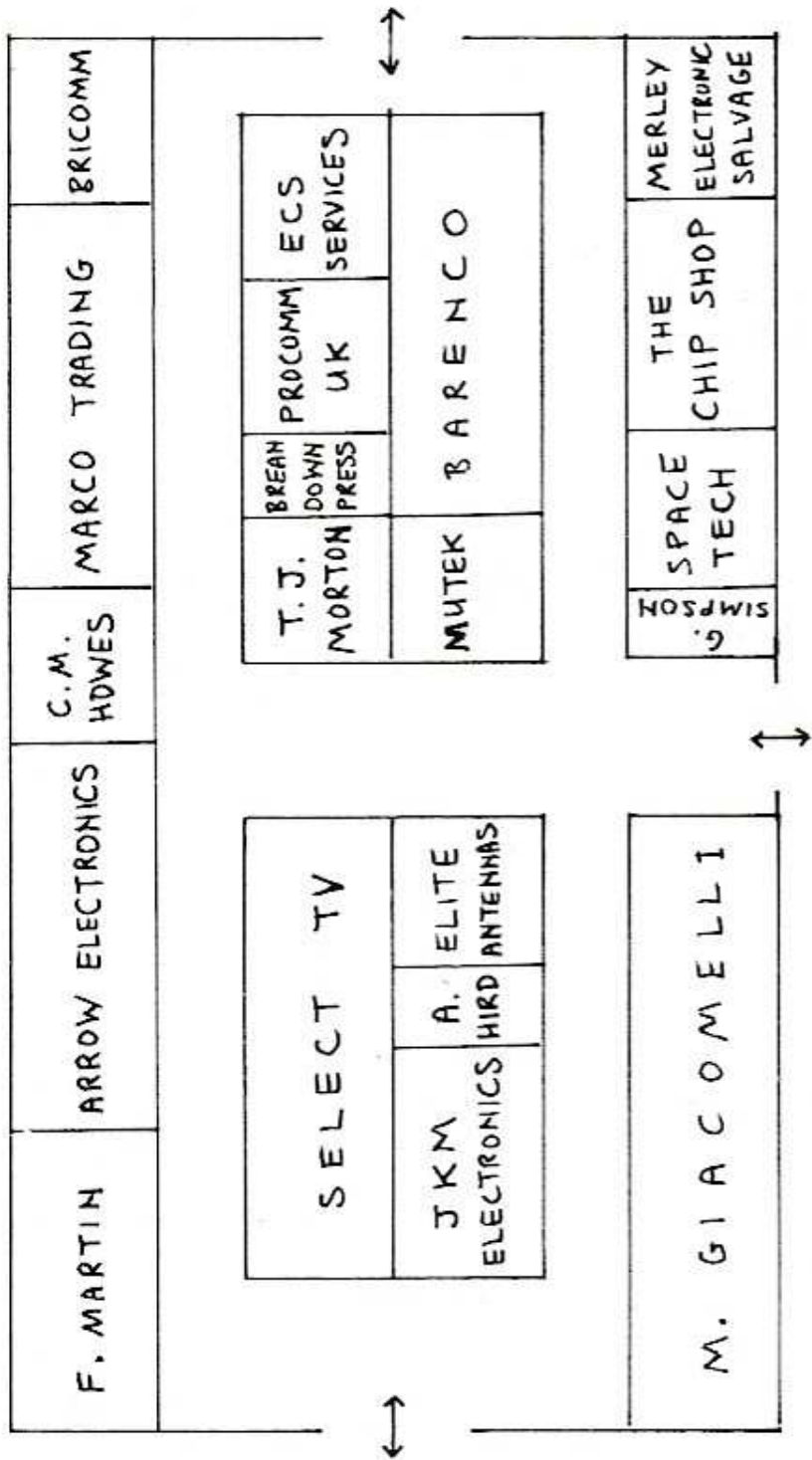

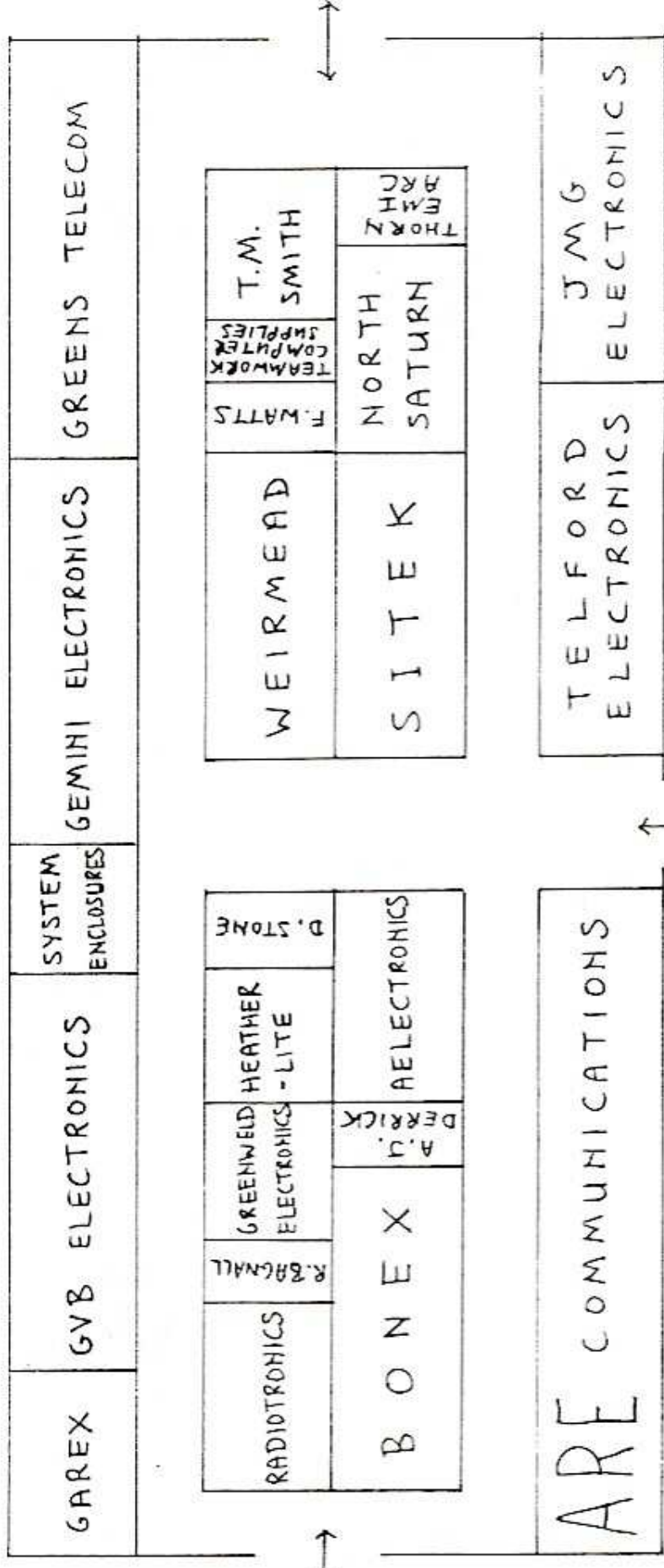

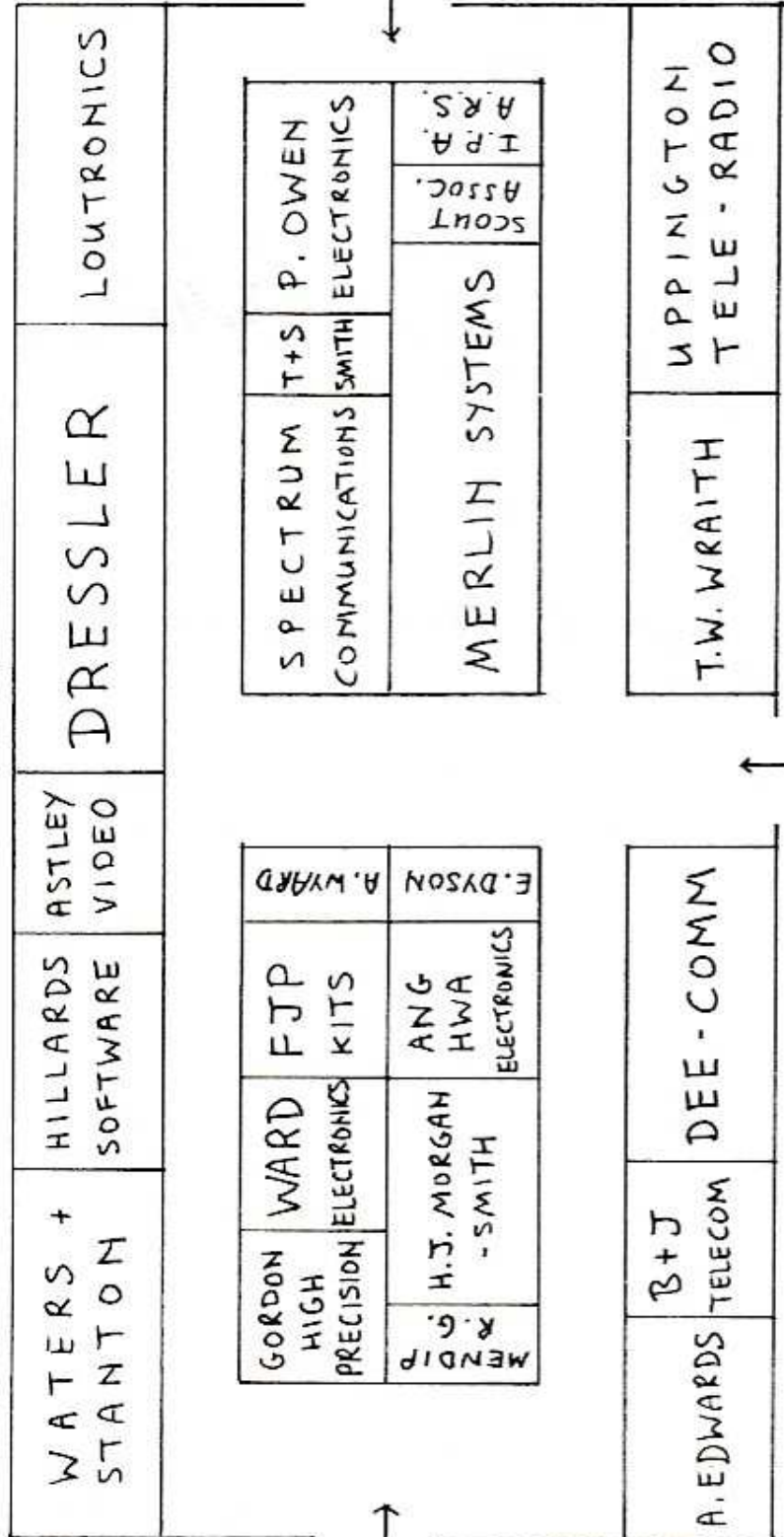

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

NO GOODS will be accepted for display unless they are accompanied by a fully complete entry form.

These forms are available at several points close to the Bring and Buy "Goods In" entrances.

A 10% commission is levied on all goods sold.

On each single item over £20 a non-returnable fixed display charge of £1 per item is made, payable when booking in.

SINGLE ITEMS NOT EXCEEDING £20

There is a non-returnable display fee of 10% of the asking price, payable when booking in. Proceeds will be passed to the seller without deduction.

REPAYMENT OF GOODS SOLD.

No repayment will be made before 12 noon.

Repayments will be made as follows: Cash payment of 50% of the selling price up to a maximum of £50, the balance of the Group's cheque.

UNSOLD GOODS

Unsold goods will only be returned on presentation of the official receipt.

All unsold goods must be claimed before 5.30 pm.

No responsibility is accepted for unclaimed goods after 5.30 pm.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

Cash sales only will be processed from the front of the stall. Buyers wishing to pay by cheque will be asked to go to the paying in point at the end of the stall. Cheques will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- 1 A cheque card and one other means of identification
- or
- 2 Two separate documents providing means of identification

The Group regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these requirements. They have been found necessary because of losses incurred by dishonoured cheques.

BEFORE PURCHASING, PROSPECTIVE BUYERS SHOULD EXAMINE THE ITEM(S) OFFERED AND ENSURE THAT THEY ARE OF SALEABLE QUALITY AND FIT FOR THE INTENDED USE.

The Group retains the right to refuse any item or items as it deems fit.



This is a worthwhile addition to any radio shack. It is granted to *any* station logging sufficient contacts with Bristol stations in postal districts BS1 – BS21 inclusive. Short wave listeners will require confirmation by a referee, or QSL cards.

Points are allocated for contacts as shown: 100 points are needed for the basic award, with endorsements for each subsequent 100 points. An endorsement can be requested for "Worked All Award Area" if contacts are made with all 21 postal districts.

Each Bristol station may be contacted once only on each band, but portable and mobile operation within the prescribed districts is taken as separate from a base station contact.

Contacts may be made via repeaters or satellites. Special Event Stations, Field Day, or Club Stations rate double points.

When 100 points have been accumulated log *extracts* under separate band headings must be confirmed by at least one other amateur and forwarded to the Bristol Activity Award Manager, G3JMY, who is QTHR, together with the callsign and location of the station. Applicants for endorsements will be issued with new up-dated certificates.
