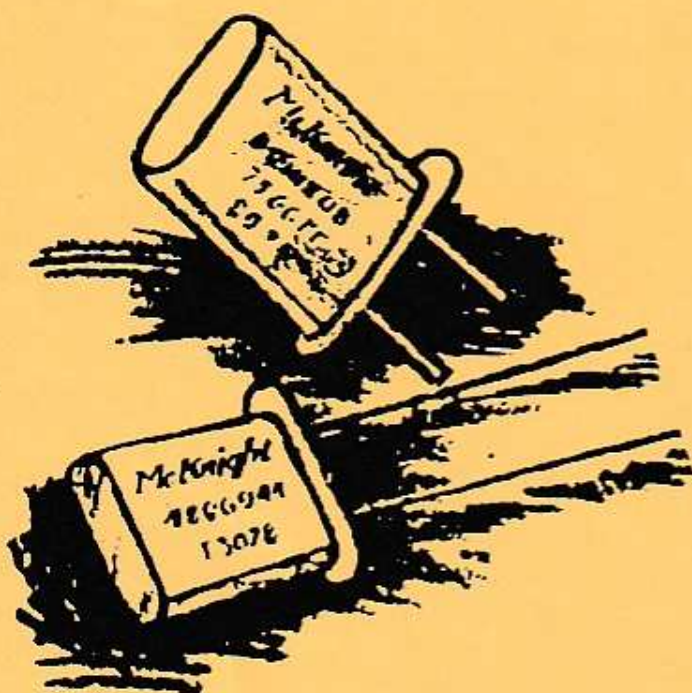


FROM THE RALLY MANAGER . . .

ABOUT THE BRISTOL RSGB GROUP

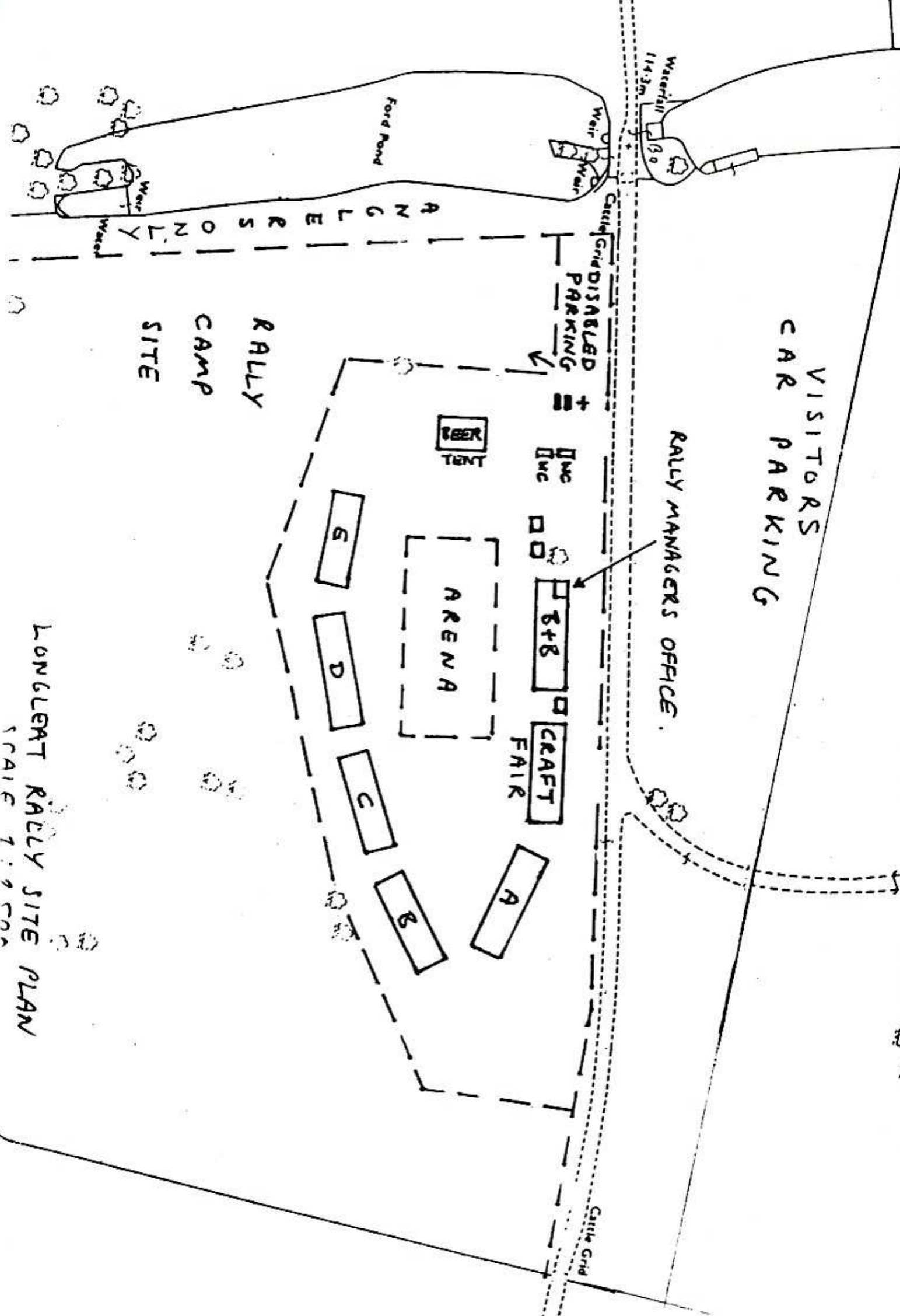

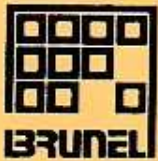
